PREFACE

The drama of humanity unfolds for each of us in a different way, and each must come to his or her own destiny alone. Along the road, there are moments that will define us. There are glimpses of a future not seen before, nor even understood. It was a moment like this that set the stage for a new course that I have been traveling now for over 30 years. As captain of the Michigan State University tennis team, I had excelled in that sport for several years. Life was wonderful. I could see my future as a head coach at a major university with a career using the skill that had rewarded me in so many ways. There was only one question in my mind, but I did not expect the answer in the way it came. I wondered, is this all there is to life?

On a tennis court one day during the summer class session, I heard a voice say, "Read the Bible, read the Bible, read the Bible." This strange voice seemed to be coming from outside of me, yet I saw no one speaking to me. The voice was so strong that I stopped the match and told my

opponent what I was hearing. He said what was happening to me was not crazy and told me to follow him.

As I remember, we walked to his car and upon opening it I discovered hundreds of books and Bibles! He put several in a box and told me to read them.

This coincidence got my attention. I began reading the Bible, and whenever I saw him, I asked him more questions. After two weeks I realized that for some reason the Creator of the universe wanted to say something to me, but I had no idea why. I recall walking outside and, under an elm tree, opening myself up to Him.

I had read the Book of John and seen that Jesus was the focal point, so I connected with that and received Him as sincerely as I knew how. At that moment, a life change occurred. A cleaning took place that brought me to tears. Then a certainty entered me that I was absolutely going to Heaven.

This was unheard of in the religion I was raised in.

Four days later my defining moment of destiny happened. I was sitting in my University dormitory room when it looked like a strong wind blew into the room and started moving pictures on the walls. I got up to close the window, then realized that the window was already closed. When I turned around, I saw Jesus walk through the door and come up to me. He extended His hand and asked me, "What are you going to do with the rest of your life?"

I thought, *I am going to play tennis*. But when I opened my mouth, I said, "I am going to gather dead bodies and pump on old hearts!" This shocked me, and I exclaimed, "Who said that?" Immediately Jesus disappeared. I could hear

His voice, but I could not see Him. He spoke to me about several things and then told me which books in my room to get rid of.

After He had instructed me, I said to Him with all respect, "No priest or tennis player or family member has ever told me that You talk to them this way, and it is hard for me to believe that I am having this intimate conversation with You. Could You send one of Your guys to talk to me in the morning when I eat breakfast at 7 . . . someone with flesh and blood that I can relate to better?"

I went to bed and, as always, went down at 7 a.m. for breakfast before work.

As I was eating, a man asked if he could sit down. I told him the table was open—it's a university table. He said he was sitting in another part of the cafeteria when Jesus spoke to him and told him to get up and to come and sit with me. He told me he was a minister and then asked me what I did. I don't remember the rest of what we talked about, but I do remember thinking that the conversation I'd had the night before was real. I thought, *Oh my, He knows everything about me!*

Is it possible to have a moment when you see a glimpse of your future? God foreknew you from the beginning of time and sees you complete, fulfilled, and wonderful. The Creator holds that picture of us before Himself every day. And He gave us Jesus as a model and example of what we look like in His dream for us.

It has been several decades since that divine encounter. A great adventure has unfolded that has carried me from the vast tundra of Siberia to the tropical forests of Asia, to Latin America, Africa, and Europe. My wife Leslie and

I continue to stand on simple platforms in open fields before vast multitudes of people from every continent. Others have estimated crowds in attendance ranging from 5,000 to 250,000 people. Over the years this has added up to standing face to face with millions of hurting humanity.

I am still amazed at the wonders I have seen when I read the testimonies of those who have experienced a transformed life or received a cure for illness that no doctor, psychologist, or man could heal.



A Muslim lady who lost her eardrum as a child when she fell into a river, suddenly bearing witness to perfect hearing, is one of 23 cases in Kazakhstan that helped thousands discover and believe in a living Savior.



A grandmother in Kyrgyzstan who had been in a wheelchair for 40 years, and whose sons had never seen her walk until then, brought tears to a tent crowd of 10,000.



In that same meeting a boy born paralyzed was lifted over the heads of the audience to the platform and walked for the first time in front of thousands.

What a witness of God's love for the Kyrgyz!



In Buenos Aires, Argentina, a young man blinded in a bar fight when a bottle was broken over his eyes, saw again for the first time since the incident, to the joy of the audience.

These and thousands of other testimonies must mean that our Jesus is alive.

I now understand what the meaning is of those first words that sprang from my spirit so long ago when Jesus appeared to me. The spiritual dead have come to life, and the hearts of believers have been pumped and recharged with hope, faith, and a fresh love for the living Christ.

Across the 23 newly-opened nations of Eurasia, we continue to raise up a generation of twenty-first century leaders in tent evangelism, releasing them to a potential they never realized was available. A great door has been opened in India to reach one billion souls, and we pursue it. We say yes to the countries who write and ask for ministry.

The Apostle John captured a powerful statement from Jesus: "Because I live, you will live also. At that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you" (John 14:19–20, KJV).

Is it now "that day" that Jesus was speaking of? I believe it is. Millions find themselves as I was, without an idea of their own potential. Now my motto is, "Empower the dreams of people for the global advancement of the Good News." So many are not awakened to the great plan of peace, purpose, and power with which the Almighty has gifted them to fulfill the dreams and desires within their hearts.

When Jesus spoke to Paul, who was on the road to Damascus to kill Christians, Jesus asked: "Why do you persecute me?" Jesus identified Himself completely with the people who believed in Him. Jesus identifies with you and me as much as God identified with Him. Jesus said that it's hard to go against the grain. It's hard to fight a battle that is already done. You can't win against a resurrected man who can't be touched. What God has put in motion will stay in motion.

When will we know this reality—the reality of our self-portrait? The day that Jesus talked about, is today. The revelation in us is unfolding now.

What do you see when you look into the mirror? Do you see your weaknesses, your inadequacies, your imperfections? Or do you see what God sees? He sees you as the righteousness of Christ Himself. He sees you as more than a conqueror in Christ! We have an opportunity to look into the mirror of God's Word—the perfect Law of liberty—and allow it to transform us from the inside out!

We must not form opinions of ourselves based upon other people's opinions or our own failures. They do not define us!

See yourself as God sees you. His idea of you is as wonderful and glorious as the Apostle Paul wrote: "But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of

the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord" (2 Cor. 3:18 NKJV).

This wonderful nugget 'made into His image' is a noble goal. It is our destiny! Men and women are fulfilled more by goals than glory or gold. Understanding position is the first step to productivity.

Men and women who find a nugget of truth, either from Scripture or personal experience, tend to remove or diminish its supernatural nature. There is something in human nature that wants to control all truth and turn it into a religion. But there are dynamics that cannot be controlled.

Everything about Jesus is supernatural—His virgin birth, His sinless life, His miracle lifestyle, His substitutionary death, His resurrection from the tomb, and His indwelling presence in humans. He is offering His kind of life for humans to discover and walk in, but it comes at the price of not being comfortable.

Change is coming—let it come for the better. Change comes from crisis or revelation. This book in your hands is a revelation of God's dream for you. Let it become *your* dream.

INTRODUCTION

Two Russian grandmothers lived on their country's border with Finland. For sixty years they were never able to cross that border. When permission was finally given for Russians to walk freely into Finland, these two grandmothers slowly proceeded along their crumbling walkway, where wild grass had always grown between the cracks, into a foreign country.

They traveled 300 feet before stepping over the border into this unknown nation. Quietly they journeyed down sturdy streets free of trash, weeds, and cracks—all the while peering up at brick buildings unstained by coal smoke.

Tears formed in their eyes as they realized they had settled for a lie their whole lives. What their foreign neighbors had was so much better than they had imagined! They had lived as paupers but were told that they were queens as they survived on bread and sausage.

The story of these grandmothers gives us a picture of most of humanity. Most people are living in spiritual poverty, but all are invited to cross the border into the fearless life of one who takes his or her place in The 12th Chair! Are we living as spiritual paupers when we should be reigning as kings and queens of the Most High and Holy God? Do we feed on the crumbs in life instead of feasting at the Father's table as legal co-heirs of His Kingdom? What are we missing by not taking our rightful place in The 12th Chair—a place purchased and paid for by the precious blood of the world's Savior, Jesus Christ?

We only discover what unlocks our best when we ask the right questions! Answers wait for the questions to be asked.

The Big Questions

Questions are the great stimulators. They cause us to think. God brings the answers to us when we begin reflecting on them.

Questions have an extraordinary capacity for finding answers. Often, asking the right question is more important than accumulating information. In His Word God tells us, "Seek the Lord." And when you seek Him with all your heart, you will find Him.¹ Thinking, pondering, and contemplating are the first steps to seeking.

When our questions rise to the level of God's potential for us, we step into a higher calling with greater possibilities. The right questions raise us to a life beyond success; they raise us to a better place—a life of significance.

¹ Jeremiah 29:13

If we don't understand this better place, we will live without powerful expectations. We will experience a lesser quality of life and a diminished view of ourselves and our God.

Humans need questions more than answers. God shows us the answer when we have the question.

So, what important questions must we ask? Here are some significant ones that we must answer to the satisfaction of our souls and minds if we are to walk in the light of our highest privilege.

- Can we continue what Jesus began 2,000 years ago?
- What releases the Miracle Life within us?
- What knowledge will produce the dignity in us to stand tall like Jesus and see His results?
- Are Biblical miracles needed in the twenty-first century?
- Why did Jesus come?
- What is the revelation of God that Jesus brought?
- Why did Jesus come in a body?
- Who does Jesus say we are?
- What makes Christianity more than a religion?
- What do we tell the world that no religion tells?
- Can Jesus be the same in you in the twenty-first century as He was in a Jew in the first century?

- Are Jesus' concepts workable or are they just a part of history?
- Are we living in the Gospels or in the Book of Acts?
- What makes us most like God?
- What are the gifts God gives every human being?
- How do we activate what we know we have?
- What brings dreams to pass?

We will find the answers to these questions on our journey through this book.

The Qualification

The Body of Christ has been qualified to sit at the table with Jesus and His followers. At the table you learn the keys of the Kingdom that Jesus gave to His Body to do what He did, and more!

What does sitting in The 12th Chair mean? It means we take our place as a voice for God's will. It means we are qualified to represent Him. It means we have been authorized to act in His authority. It means we have the same access to God the Father that Jesus has. It means we are highly favored and privileged!

It is God's Good News demonstrated that produces dignity in all human beings!

I would not dare approach the important subject of the miracle life if I were not supported by the following:

- The Bible is a supernatural book!
- Jesus had a supernatural birth!
- Jesus gave us examples of supernatural miracles!
- Jesus experienced a supernatural resurrection!
- I had a supernatural encounter with Him!
- We are all called to do what He does!

God is Spirit in Heaven, and He indwells flesh in the earth. This life that the Creator offers us by fusing us to Himself overrides all the limitations of our existence. Jesus introduced the idea that all things are possible with God (Matt. 19:26). For three-and-a-half years, Jesus showed what God in flesh can do. Then He made it possible for God to live in *our* flesh.

This Life Supersedes Nature

Have you ever stopped a storm? Jesus did. In a boat when all others feared for their lives, He spoke peace and the winds obeyed! Over the years we have seen the power of the Name of Jesus in similar situations when storm winds threatened our events.

It is truly a wonder when the winds respond to that name. It happened in the northern desert of Mexico at a church roof dedication. We were suddenly pounded by a mighty wind and rain such as the people had not experienced before. First, the side windows began to rattle. Then the roof we were dedicating began tearing off, panel by panel, right

above the pulpit. The people ran for the door and the walls. I did also, but Leslie stood her ground at the pulpit and commanded the storm to stop in the name of Jesus. After she said the name three times, the wind and rain instantly stopped. The roof was saved and we had a glorious celebration!

This Life Supersedes Medical Science

Have you ever healed someone of an incurable disorder? Jesus did when a woman with an incurable blood disease touched Him. Recently I had an amazing experience—celebrating with two lepers who had received their healing at one of our previous meetings, and had returned to testify of their wonderful experience. Both had obtained a Doctor's report stating that their leper days were over! Indeed, one of them, an eighty-year-old woman also received her sight back, to the amazement of the crowd. We continue to see the "incurables" touch Jesus when His Word reaches their hearts, and they walk away healed.

This Life Supersedes the Law of Death

Jesus saw the dead rise when He called Lazarus from the grave (John 11:43–44). Can this happen today? We've heard of it happening in numerous places in Africa and Mexico. During our ministry in Ivory Coast, we heard of a woman who died during the event and was put in a wheelbarrow to be taken back to her village. On the way home a sudden, unexplainable miracle happened! Her eyes opened and life came back into her body. She told her son to stop pushing the wheelbarrow—she was going to walk!

What does the world want? They want good news. They want a demonstration of that good news. They want dignity.

We have stood among the 18,000 Buddhist temples of Bangkok and watched offerings of appeasement being made continually to their unknown gods to keep bad things from happening.

We have seen the Japanese in their Shinto temples trying to cleanse the sin from within by breathing deeply from incense-laden bowls.

We have driven by the long, candle-lit processions of people in Mexico on their knees in penance, making sacrifices to ancient statues in hopes that a dead saint would intercede for them.

We have lived among the Russian Orthodox who chant their ancient language in churches. They don't understand what they are saying, and therefore the rituals cannot help the people.

During fifty centuries of Hindu philosophy, a religion has emerged with over 10,000 ways to communicate with a collection of 300 million gods. We have seen their thirst for God—it is unmatched in the world. Millions of Hindus go down to the Ganges River in India with the hope that their sins will be washed away, but the water cannot wash out the stain of sin.

For years we have worked among ancient Islamic civilizations with their repetitious daily prayers. They are searching for removal of yesterday's stain of sin, assurance of today's answered prayer, and confidence in future heavenly salvation. Without certainty in their hearts of any of this, they struggle.

The world has seen the prayer wheels of Nepal that must constantly be turned, in hope that the gods will give attention to man's need. Their monks believe in reincarnation, so they endure their chosen life of suffering, hoping they will not have to suffer in the next life.

We will not take the time to tell of the mountain trek to the cannibals of Aurora in the Philippines, or of the pilgrimage across China, or of the work among European secularists. Without miracles it would be impossible to convince the people of the world of a living Christ. Christianity would become just one of many philosophies without the confirmation of truth that only the Gospel guarantees.

CHAPTER 1

FINDING THE RIGHT CHAIR

The early church imitated Christ. Should we?

What did Jesus begin that we continue?

Can Jesus be the same in His Word as He was in person? What did the disciples see, and not see, in the Cross?

Are we living in the Gospels or in the Book of Acts?

I walked into a bookstore looking for a small New Testament. What I found were thousands of books on every type of religion, philosophy, and self-help technique that one could imagine. Man's quest for truth is commendable. But without a guiding star to point the way, mankind would soon be lost in a myriad of opinions.

Religion teaches people how to suffer.

God teaches people how to make the devil suffer!

There are so many cultures and so-called gods in the earth. How could the Creator, the true God, be justified to all people of all generations in His dealings with mankind? He chose to come Himself, reveal Himself, and pay a price Himself for all humanity. This way, He would be justified in His judgment of the world.

Emmanuel, God with us in human form, is one of the names of Jesus. It is the revelation of Jesus that is the only real division in this world of different ethnic, social, and cultural differences. He rests His whole Kingdom and future on His own identity. We see this clearly in His question to Peter in Matthew 16:13: "Who do men say that I am?" The disciples spoke of the common thoughts of men when they answered that some thought Jesus was another prophet, or teacher, or a reincarnation of past great men. But when Peter said what was in his heart—that Jesus was the Messiah, the Christ, the One sent from God to redeem His people—then Jesus had a truth that He could build on. He said this truth was the rock that the Church would be built on and that no power would be able to stop it.

Then Jesus went further and revealed the authority on earth that those who believed this revelation would have. Whatever a believer stops or starts on earth will be recognized in Heaven and enforced with Heaven's power (Matt. 16:19). Jesus took the revelation of Himself and turned it into a revelation of mankind whom He would indwell.

Our life is short and eternity hangs on the choices we make during this vapor of time (James 4:14). Who will be our model to follow in this brief earthly interlude before we meet our Master? We can trust Jesus Christ as our model. He is believable. He is a trustworthy leader and an example for the ages.

In the face of storms, Jesus spoke peace and all became calm. In the face of taxes, He said to go fishing and gold was found. In the face of lack, He spoke blessing over bread and multiplication occurred. In the face of devils, He spoke a word and they were cast out. In the face of corrupt governments, He remained steady while they trembled in His presence.

We are called to walk in His likeness!

Jesus is calling us to follow Him into this same kind of life that He had on earth. He came as our miracle model. He gave us the power to live the miracle life when He gave us the Holy Spirit. Let us discover what we have so we can be who we really are.

When we know what we have from God, we know who we are. When we know who we are, we know what we can do!

Anthropologists spend billions of dollars studying our past in hopes of knowing our present purpose. For us who believe, our past is rooted in the creation of man by God. We are made in His image, after His likeness.² Therefore Adam, the first man, was without sin and was a perfect reflection of His Creator. Scripture says that Adam's son was born in his likeness, after his image, and he named him Seth³. This was the pattern that God wanted to use to create a race of people like Himself.

Does it really matter that we lift the standard of a life like Jesus? The apostle Paul tells us in his letter to the Roman church that the whole creation is longing for the revealing of the sons (and daughters) of God (Romans 8:19). I think the world has been waiting a long time, and this generation has the potential, knowledge, and equipment to really shine as Jesus did.

This gives us a glimpse of God's original dream—to start a family with the potential to walk and behave like Him. Adam failed. He disobeyed God and did not fulfill God's dream. But God sent Jesus, Whom Scripture calls the last Adam,4 and He did not fail. Jesus is the model for us to follow. How do we model ourselves after Jesus? Do we wear long robes with long hair and beards? It is interesting that in the four Gospels the writers did not talk about His appearance; His nose, the color of His eyes, His muscles, His height, His posture, or His hair. This is how popular writers describe their heroes in the books written today, but the Gospels are different. They are full of His words and His wonders. He is our model in response, action, compassion, authority, wisdom, purpose and power. We duplicate Him through the power of the new birth. The new birth is the ability to become God's child.⁵ To as many as received Him, He gave power to become the sons and daughters of God. Paul tells us to put on this new man that is renewed in knowledge after the image of Him who created him.6

All the potential of Jesus as the Son of God was placed in seed form in you as a child of God!

You might say that this is unrealistic. Man is a sinner bound to sin and can never live up to the standard of Jesus' example. Well, what do you say about your children? When do you as a parent disqualify them?

When reasonable adults decide to have children, they are not under some misguided notion that there isn't going to be any misbehavior on the part of those children. Before the conception process even begins, they are fully aware that many problems will come as a result of their decision to have children, but the relationship is worth it to them.

It would have been easy for God to create us without the freedom of choice, but how meaningful could a relationship of that nature be? God knows full well the complexity of what is involved in the process of our obedience becoming genuine, from the heart, rather than something motivated by the fear of reprisal. And He is willing to endure "whatever it takes" to see that happen. Who's to say that the wait doesn't contribute to the joy for Him? I'm persuaded that nothing else is able to satisfy His great heart.

PART 1

THE SELECTION

It was a time of great upheaval! It was a time of signs, wonders, and miracles! It was the birth of a new era!

Those caught up in the change did not fathom the depth of the revolution in thought, faith, and worldview that was quickly emerging. It was this new revelation of Jesus Christ being raised from the dead that captivated them!

After He rose from the grave, Jesus had appeared to His disciples for forty days, speaking of a new Kingdom. He had given them the keys and command of this Kingdom, and He had told them to go to the whole world with it.

We find this group of eleven handpicked disciples, along with 100 more early followers, deciding that they definitely were committed to this new way. They were not clear on exactly what to do, and the waiting in the Upper Room seemed too long, so they acted.

Their first act was to fill *The 12th Chair*. This was the chair that Judas Iscariot, the betrayer of Jesus, had occupied. There was much debate over this 12th chair. Who was worthy of sitting at the table with the eleven who had been personally selected by Jesus? Who would be a qualified representative of the risen Lord? They were looking for one body to sit in that chair, but God had already chosen a body since the beginning of time. Who was it?

Matthias listened with interest as the eleven Apostles debated the need for a twelfth. He had been one of the seventy disciples sent out by Jesus for some practical training in preaching. He was as surprised as the others when the devils listened to him and came out. He never thought anybody took notice, and now his compatriots were lifting him up to the highest status. In the back of his mind he wondered, was this really supposed to happen? Jesus appeared to all of us on several occasions after His resurrection, but He never mentioned this. Is this how God does things? Drawing straws?

Matthias heard the qualifications for the job, and he was one of many who passed the simple exam. The idea haunted his thoughts: was he really God's choice for the 12th Chair?


What happened a few days later made God's choice clear. Historic changes were unfolding. One era was fading as a new one blossomed. The sun brought the morning light that day as it always had, but something besides sunlight was falling from the sky. Tongues of fire filled the Upper Room where the Apostles and the rest of Jesus' 120 most faithful followers were praying. The holy fire rested on each head as the third person of the Godhead filled the room. The Holy Spirit filled them all and they went out preaching, teaching, speaking, and proclaiming the good things of God in languages unknown to them but understood by all the nations assembled in Jerusalem that day. God had made His choice for The 12th Chair: it would be the Body of Christ!

The Apostles thought the qualifications for the one to occupy this chair were that he had to have walked with them from the beginning and have been a physical witness to the resurrection of Jesus. Again, God had another idea!

God breathed His Spirit into everyone who would believe in His Son Jesus, just as He had breathed upon Adam in the Garden, and he became a living soul. Millions were about to enter into perfect harmony with God the Father—the harmony that Adam had enjoyed before he fell.

We catch a glimpse of God's decision by His selection of Stephen the church administrator, Philip the usher, and Paul the persecutor of the church—as well as millions more who would soon be sitting in the authority of Christ.

The religious world claims its authority in the physical church based on historic succession. Many institutions claim apostolic succession from the first disciples for their authority. Was it Jesus' plan to start another man-made institution run by a few men that would start the cycle of corruption and decay over again? No! God had a better idea and very big plans for The 12th Chair!
